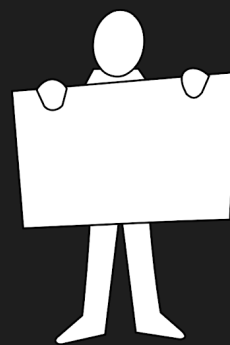
SPEECH

POSTER

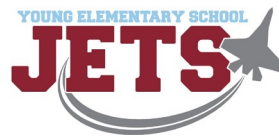
You will make a poster announcing you are running and submit a picture of the poster by 2/3. Poster slide show will be shown each day.
